Visitors of SICMAT booth (Pad.2 G14 H13) Fair will have the opportunity to see the most innovative gear finishing machines on the market in operation. This year we are presenting the new **RASO 400 Siemens Solution Line®**, as well as two strongly innovative models : the shaving machine **RASO 250 Twin Power** and the honing machine **GRONO 250**. The RASO 250 TP defines new performance standards (in terms of cycle times and quality of the finished gear) for an utilization in high volume productions.

Main peculiarities : vertical workpiece axis synchronized with the shaving cutter; quick and flexible integrated automation; cross slide axes with linear motors.

With Grono 250 Sicmat enters the field of **honing technology**.

Here finishing follows the thermal treatment and the tool is a honing wheel.

The "mission" of this machine is to keep the advantages of the Raso series in honing too : constructive simplicity and practicalness of use. This involves a lower initial investment as well as lower exercise costs in the production process for the user. the innovative characteristic is the use of a honing wheel with external toothing, similar to the shaving cutter in terms of sizes.
